We unite and celebrate again in the Dominican Church from Monday the 8th of June 2020 on

Dear sisters and brothers, dear friends,

Our Dominican community is very happy to be able to inviting you and to uniting again for celebrations and prayers in our church, Renaissancelaan 40, 1000 Brussels. We have organised the restart in this way :

TIMETABLE - Attention : there are some changes.

From Monday > Friday: eucharist at 7.00 p.m. in the church

On Saturdays : eucharist at 7.00 p.m. for the polish community

On Sundays : eucharist at 9.00 a.m. for the polish community
eucharist in French at 11.30 a.m. – no service for the children
eucharist multilingual at 6.00 p.m.
eucharist at 8.00 p.m. for the polish community

MANDATORY GUIDELINES

You only enter through the small door as usual

Each person brings their mask and hand gel.

There is a maximum of 100 people per celebration

FULL CHURCH ? ARE THERE NO MORE FREE PLACES ?

Please, come to the celebration you were used to.

Never come 2 x per weekend

If the maximum people is reached, please be welcome on weekdays at 7:00 p.m.

ENTRERING THE CHURCH

Please follow the directions of the reception team

At the entrance: we line up with a distance of 1.5 meters

In the church: we wash our hands

You will guided to a seat - we do not choose ourselves:

- either a single seat, 2 for a couple, or 6 for a family

Please do not move the chairs.

The toilets are not accessible.

The holy water font is out of service

DURING THE CELEBRATIONS

Please stay at your place till the end of the celebration.
Communion will be brought to you in your place.
We receive communion on the hand.
There are no leaflets, songbooks; no singing nor choir song.
The collection is done after celebration at the exit in a basket.

TO LEAVE THE CHURCH

We all wait for the indications that will be given
The celebrant leaves first.
He greets you from a distance at the exit door
A sign will be given, row by row to exit, starting with the last row.
The only exit is where the celebrant stands.
There are no crowds on the sidewalk after the celebrations
And keep distance when meeting each other afterwards.

VOLUNTEERS

We need volunteers for each celebration:

- > 3 reception volunteers (entrance; hand washing; indicate chairs)
- > 5 volunteers to disinfect after each celebration
